

Indigenous Voice co-design process

The Australian Government committed in 2019 to undertake a process of co-design to develop models and options for an Indigenous voice and to enhance local and regional decision-making.

The Indigenous Voice Co-design Process Final Report to the Australian Government is now publically available.

The Final Report outlines an Indigenous Voice made up of two parts that work together: Local & Regional Voices and a National Voice.

The Indigenous Voice aims to provide a way for Indigenous Australians to have a greater say on the design, development and implementation of policies and programs that affect them.

The Final Report is the result of an extensive process of co-design and consultation with both Indigenous and non-Indigenous Australians across the country.

For the Indigenous Voice to work, it must have a strong foundation from the ground up. As recommended in the Final Report, the next step is to progress the establishment of Local & Regional Voices.
